What is the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (MFIPPA)?

The <u>Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (MFIPPA)</u> is the provincial law that requires the protection of personal information, and provides individuals with a right of access to public records. *MFIPPA* has specific exemptions and limitations regarding access to personal information collected, used, retained, disclosed and disposed of by School Boards.

How do I make a formal (FOI) request under MFIPPA?

You may make a request under *MFIPPA* by completing the request form. Completed forms must include an application fee of \$5.00, which may be paid by cash or cheque, payable to the Halton Catholic District School Board. Please provide as much detail as possible about the information you are requesting.
